

**LEE-RUSSELL PUBLIC TRANSIT PASSENGER GUIDE AMENDMENT
JUNE 1, 2009**

This is an amendment to the Lee-Russell Public Transit Passenger Guide dated September 29, 2008.

Page 12

BOARDING: Effective immediately, the new rule for passenger boarding time is as follows:

All medical appointments, classes, employment and all other pickups with a definite time for arriving will be scheduled as “Drop-offs”. If your appointment is at 9:00 a.m., you will be scheduled as a 9:00 a.m. drop-off. This means you must be ready to board the bus up to one hour prior to this drop-off time. The bus may arrive to pick you up for your scheduled trip as early as 8:00 a.m. You must be ready when the bus arrives. The driver will wait for you only five minutes, and then leave. The driver will not return later to pick you up.

All return trips will be scheduled as “Pick-ups”. If you have scheduled to be picked up from work, school, shopping, etc., the vehicle will not arrive prior to your pickup time. However, it may be up to one-half hour after your scheduled pickup time. Again, the driver will only wait five minutes. If you do not board the bus during this five minute period, the driver will leave and no other bus will return to pick you up on that day.
